

“Intensive Beginning Soldering”

Class Description: In this 2 day class you will learn the in's and outs of soldering. You will leave with an understanding of what you did and the confidence to go forward after you leave. We will first go over torch and fuel safety and talk about the fuels available and the differences between them. You will learn the difference between the size of the flame and heat control, different soldering techniques such as pick soldering and sweat soldering and when to use them, how to bezel set a stone, how to solder small components without a 'meltdown', about the tools and supplies needed and why, and tips to help you get 'out of trouble' when something doesn't work and much, much more! At the end of this very intense class you will have 4 pieces of jewelry (you love) that you will take home with you. (A butane torch is utilized in this class.)
